

## Key views

# All areas to be planted up with woodland (D1 and D2), individual trees (D3) and scrub (D4) to be seeded in the first instance with an establishment grass sward mix (D9), prior to spraying off before planting.

- All plants to be protected by plastic shelters and stakes.
- Plant and seed schedules, establishment details and aftercare requirements are provided in the Landscape and Visual Impact Assessment at Appendix D.
- Cross section of typical lake edge profile is provided at LVIA Appendix A Figure A2D.
